


Year 1 Home Learning – Summer 1

Choose one activity from the grid to do each week during the half term. Please do not feel that you have to complete all of the activities unless you really want to! Please upload any photos or evidence to your Class Dojo portfolios for us to see.

<p><u>Science</u></p> <p></p> <p><u>Wild Flowers</u></p> <p>Go on an outdoor adventure with your family. Can you find a new place to go for a walk? While you are out; see how many types of wild flowers you can spot. Write a list of the ones you found and take some photos to share with your class.</p> <p>Ask me: What flowers can you see? What do they look like? What shapes are the petals/ leaves.</p> <p>Challenge: Make a tally chart of types of flowers that you see. What did you see most/least of?</p>	<p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>Go on a 3d shape indoor and outdoor hunt. Look for cube, cuboid, cone, triangular based pyramid, square based pyramid, sphere. Use the 3d shape mat to help you.</p> <p>Ask Me: What How many faces/edges/vertices does that shape have?</p> <p>Challenge: Play what is my shape? Using a feely bag, get someone to put in different objects. You have to use your sense of touch to describe it and say what 3d shape it is closest to.</p>	<p><u>Phonics</u></p> <p>https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/resources</p> <p>Play:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Buried Treasure • Dragons Den • Picnic On Pluto <p>Go into phase 5</p> <p>Practise sounding out and reading the real and fake words out loud with someone who can read them with you.</p> <p>Ask me: What digraphs can you see?</p> <p>Challenge: Using the different digraphs can you make up some of your own fake words?</p>
<p><u>History</u></p> <p>Talk with your family about your personal history.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can they talk to you about when you were born? Look at baby photos. • What can you remember as a toddler? Talk to family about their memories. • What can you do now that you couldn't do as a baby, toddler. <p>Make an – ‘All About Me’ booklet or scrap book. You can include photo's, drawings, memories.</p>	<p><u>Geography: London</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1.Can you find out 5 facts about London? 2. Choose a London landmark to draw and find out 3 facts about it. <p>Ask me: Can you label the different parts of the landmark? Why have you chosen that landmarks?</p> <p>Challenge: Can you build a model of your favourite London landmark? You can use any material you want to. Take a photo or bring it in to show us.</p>	<p><u>Writing/ Science</u></p> <p>Choose an animal and write a fact file about it. You could include what it eats, what it looks like, where it lives! These could be your sub-headings.</p> <p>Ask me: What animal have you chosen? Does a fact file need a heading? Does it need sub headings? Can you include some facts? Can you draw a picture of the animal and label the different body parts? Can you write a caption for the picture?</p> <p>Challenge: Can you extend any sentences using the connective ‘and’</p>

Maths

Bake some number bonds to 10 biscuits.

Find a recipe to follow to bake some biscuits and when you get to the decorating stage, try icing your biscuits and putting a line down the middle to split them in half. Then using 10 smarties/ sprinkles etc, make a number bond to 10. For example: 6 and 4. If you fancy an even more difficult challenge.

Ask me: What measurements do you need to use for your ingredient?



Challenge: Make some bigger biscuits and try some number bonds to 20!
